A500 – Advanced Appraisal Exam Preparation Course

This is an advanced course that is intended to assist students in preparing for Comprehensive Exams and to assist them in entering the proper mindset for working complex appraisal problems. Technology Applications in Appraisal – Google Earth Seminar

This is an update of the California Chapter's original Google Earth class. This hands-on course will introduce the mapping tools of the trade, focusing on Google Earth. It will delve into the many ways that this product can be used in the appraisal profession to increase efficiency. Students will learn the fundamentals, advanced operations, file system, layer system, data management, and data applications associated with the Google Earth program. They will learn to import and export pertinent information to and from Google Earth and will leave with the knowledge and resources needed to implement the tools provided into their appraisal practice. The classroom presentation will consist of interactive demonstrations and class discussions. Participants will have access to the Google Earth layers discussed and demonstrated.


